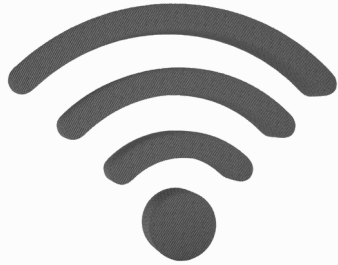

Friday all-day & Saturday morning: Ground floor, The Lundbeckfond Auditorium

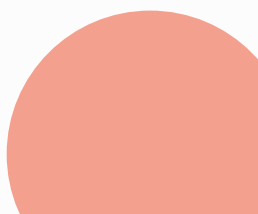

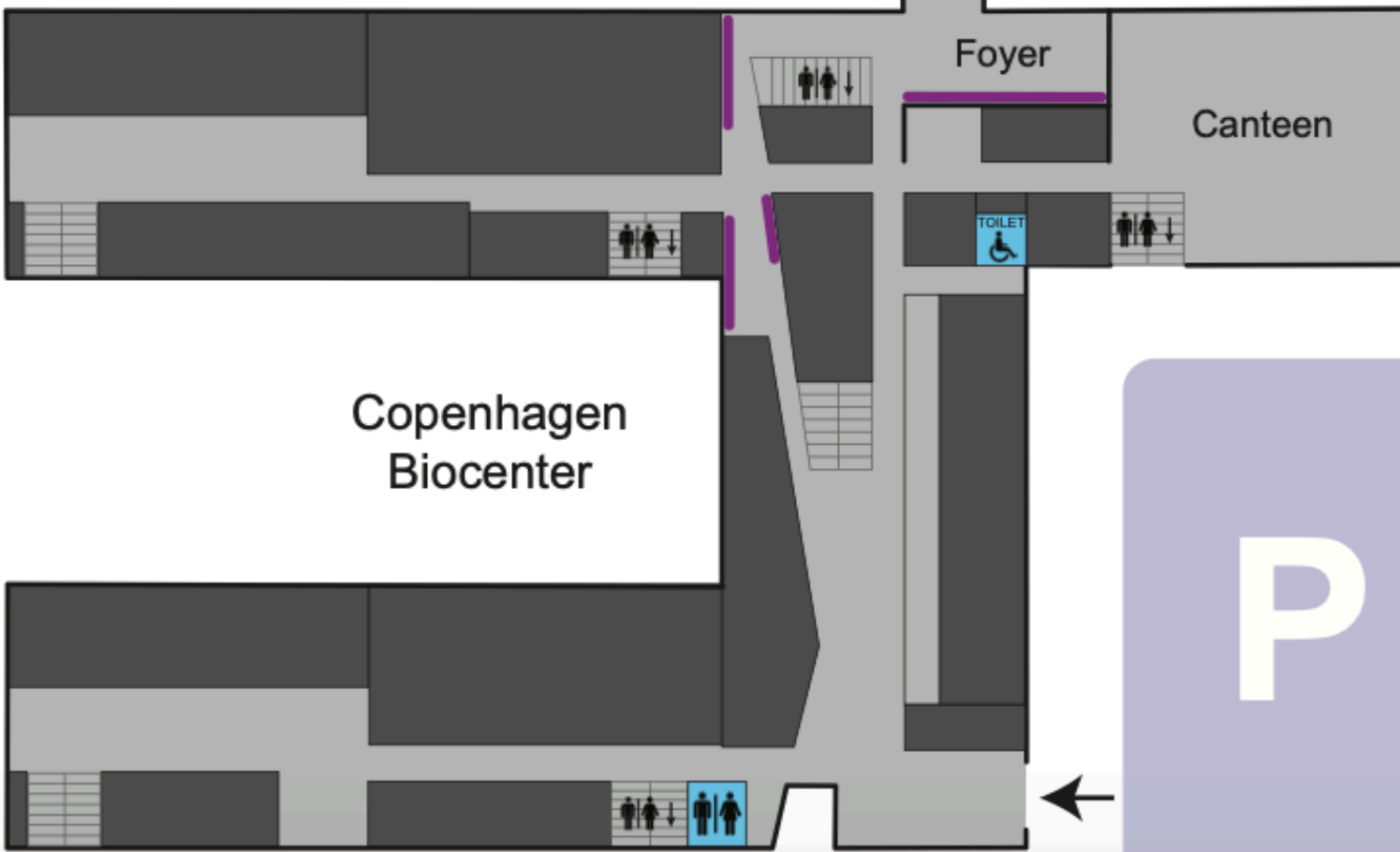
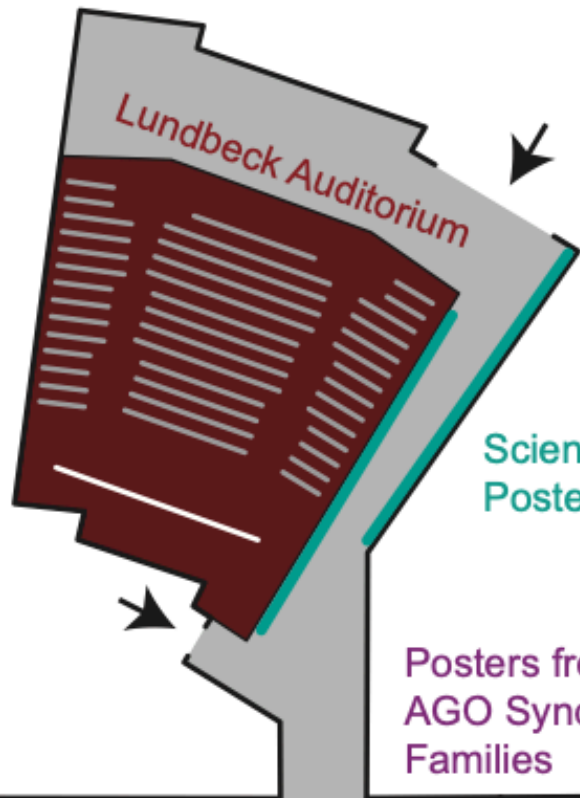

Getting around

- You can use Google Maps to see how to get around
- Buying tickets for public transport
 - [Ticket information](#)
 - Use the red 'DSB' ticket machine at metro stations and airport.
 - Or download the 'DOT Tickets' app if you have data on your phone
- From the airport you can take a metro or train to the central station - from there you can either catch a bus or walk to the hotel (1km about 15 minutes on foot). There is only one Metro line at the airport, and the airport is at the end of the line. You won't be able to miss it.
- To get from the hotel to the conference venue, we suggest you take a train from Dybbølsbro, and change to bus 6A at Nørreport station. This bus has the closest stop to the venue
- Uber does not operate in Denmark so regular taxis are the only option if you do not wish to use the public transportation system.
